3. PACKING MILESTONES & ESSENTIALS CHECK

- ☐ **Systematic Color-Coding & Labeling**
Mark box numbers and destination rooms on at least two side panels and top flaps so removal crews can place boxes directly.
- ☐ **Isolate High-Priority "Open-First" Essentials Box**
Pack kettle, mugs, coffee/tea, phone chargers, toilet roll, bed sheets, hand tools, and immediate medication in a distinctly marked box.

INVENTORY TIP FROM SAMEDAY REMOVALS

Number every box sequentially and note high-value items in this master inventory log. This makes it effortless to verify that all containers have arrived safely at your new home before the moving crew departs.
