Record furniture sizes, doorway measurements, hardware inventory, and room placement before moving day.

3. HARDWARE INVENTORY & PRE-MOVE PROTOCOL

- ☐ **Bag & Label Assembly Screws and Fixtures**
Place screws, dowels, shelf pegs, and allen keys into clear zip-lock bags and tape them securely to the corresponding furniture body.
- ☐ **Secure Moving Clearance with Doorway Measurements**
Compare sofa and mattress diagonal depth against the narrowest doorway dimensions to ensure smooth entry without wall scuffs.

FURNITURE HANDLING TIP FROM SAMEDAY REMOVALS

When measuring sofas, check the diagonal depth (from the bottom back corner to the top front of the armrest). If the diagonal depth is less than your doorway width, the sofa can be rotated through the doorway safely!
